Dorm: Students live in university-style suites with 3 bedrooms, 2 bathrooms, and a commons area. Usually, students live two to a bedroom and up to six in a suite. The large commons area on each floor has a kitchenette and is the go-to hang-out space for students to play games, study, and chat. The recreation room in the basement is used for ping pong and students who want to

have lively fun. Students have access to the school's athletic facilities and often participate in after-school activities due to the ease of walking to school.

**Community:** The school culture is like a family; safe, inviting, loving, fun, and supportive. Cultivating relationships and building community is very important. Students are encouraged to hang out with students from school and invite them to the dormitory. Our Dorm Parents are always present in the dorm and get to know each individual student very well.
