HIGHLIGHTS OVER THE YEARS

<u>1968-69</u>

- 9/15/68 ML dedication service \$2.3 million to build.
- 90 freshman and sophomores.
- 9:1 pupil to teacher ratio.
- ◆ 10/5 1st football game, against Milwaukee Lutheran's JV team, which was supposed to be their freshman team. We lost 48-0.
- Lost all our games, but gained experience.
- 10/25 1st Arbor Day, planted 200 trees and stored 140 more. Lucy Walters's dad drove his tractor all the way to the school to dig the tree holes for planting.
- ◆ 11/14-16 1st drama play, "The Death and Life of Sneaky Fitch", adult tickets \$1.
- ◆ 11/22 1st school newsletter, "The Rag".
- 1969 Movie "Romeo & Juliet"; premiere showing in downtown Milwaukee attended by Mr. Lohmeyer, Karen Knoll, Kathy McCrindle and Ric Simon. Then entire school got to see it.
- House parties throughout the year; I was invited to 9, only because I had records.

<u>1969-70</u>

- JV football now; 6 wins & 3 losses, but still loss to Milwaukee Lutheran 6-8.
- 1st year with a track team Mr. Doepke teaching calisthenics w/ paperback book.

<u>1970-71</u>

- ◆ Varsity football 2 wins & 4 losses, but we beat Milwaukee Lutheran 14-6.
- Milwaukee Sunday Journal read, "QB Tim Schneider threw 8-yard scoring pass to Dave Drews with only 4 seconds left." Our 1st varsity win.

+ Our 2nd win was against Racine Lutheran 14-0, "Capped off by 2-yard plunge by fullback Dan Schneider". School Expansions:

- Library 7,500 volumes for \$450 and 2,000 books donated.
- Chapel Egg cartons on ceiling for acoustics; Mr. Lohmeyer was able to get an organ being sold by a church for \$2,000 at the low price of \$275, and then led the task of rebuilding it. Parents, teachers and students helped to build a larger stage and elevated seating, an altar plus coverings and lectern, crosses and banners.
- ◆ 12/11/70 Renamed school newsletter, "Spectrum".
- $6/06/71 1^{st}$ commencement ceremony.

<u> 1971-72</u>

- Football 2nd in conference w/ 4 wins and 2 losses (flipped from last year). Homecoming game we beat Milwaukee Lutheran again, 20-18.
- Homecoming Dance Band did not show up as they double booked and dumped us without notification.
- My folks were there for the beginning, heard the bad news and rushed home to get my records. Dance was saved.
- ★ Mr. Storm and Mr. Lohmeyer went before the Musicians Union Board to file complaint in professional and respectable manner. That band was banned from union membership and dropped by booking agency. We received a free band at our next dance. A great example of standing up for what is right when faced with difficulty.

- ◆ TUITION '68 & '69 = \$325; '70 = \$450; '71 = \$483. Now = \$13,000 w/o discounts
