# **Upcoming Calendar Change Parent-Teacher Conferences**

For several reasons, we are asking everyone to take note of an upcoming change to the ML academic year calendar.

The Parent-Teacher Conferences (PTC) previously scheduled for March 9 and 10 are being pushed back by one week, and these 2 days are now regular school days.

The new PTC will take place one night only on <u>Thursday, March 16 between</u> <u>the hours of 5-8 p.m.</u> There will be no morning PTC sessions on Friday, March 17, and there is no school on this day.

The recent downward trends of Spring PTC attendance indicate that this change/reduction of meeting time opportunities will have little impact on families. # **Digital Tickets for Home Athletic Events**



### MARTIN LUTHER ATHLETICS HOME GAME TICKET PROTOCOLS

All tickets must be purchased online at http://spicket.events/martinluther. No cash at the gate.

- 1. Tickets will go on sale one week before each event start date.
- 2 For all games, ticket sales will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the varsity game on the day of the event. (This is subject to change for larger events and will be communicated ahead of time)
- 3. Gates will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of all Varsity games. Anyone not in the event at that time will not be allowed to enter.
- 4. No refunds will be given unless the game is canceled.
- s. There will be no re-entry upon exiting the event.
- 6. All middle/elementary school students must be accompanied by an adult.
- 7. Conference and ML passes will still be accepted. No digital ticket required.
- 8. Children 6 and under are free with an adult; no ticket is required for the child
- 9. Martin Luther students are allowed in for free with their student ID. No digital ticket required. Must have ID.
- 10. Martin Luther staff members are allowed in for free with a Staff ID. No digital ticket required. Must have ID.
- n. No free admission or passes for WIAA events. Digital ticket required.

# **Wisconsin Tax Deduction**

Beginning with the tax year 2014, the State of Wisconsin has introduced a new legislation (Wis. Stat. § 71.05(6)(b)49), in which private school tuition payments paid on or after January 1, 2014 are now eligible for an annual income tax deduction. Qualified taxpayers may potentially claim up to the deduction limit for each dependent child in grades Kindergarten through 8th and up to the deduction limit for each dependent child in grades 9th through 12th. Tuition claimed must be paid in the tax year in which it is being filed. This 2022 tax year, many families may have two tax statements, one from TADS and another from SchoolAdmin. Below are the links for you to access both systems to get your information.

#### TADS (2021-22 or prior)

For any payments made in the tax year 2022 for the 2021-22 school year or prior, you will need to access a tax form from TADS. You can log into <u>TADS</u>. If you have any questions, please reach out to TADS at 1-800-477-8237.

#### SchoolAdmin (2022-23 or later)

For any payments made for the tax year 2022 for the 2022-23 school year, you will need to access the tax form from <u>SchoolAdmin</u>. To obtain your tuition payments, log into your SchoolAdmin account and click the billing tab. The tax statement is a link located within the ledger header.
