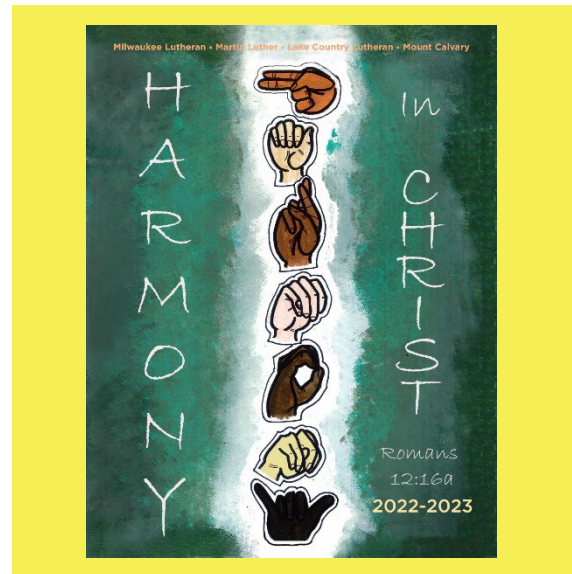

Behavior – Discipline Policies

Self-discipline is the most effective form of student control. However, when student conduct does not comply with the Martin Luther policies and procedures, appropriate action will be taken. Appropriate action may include a verbal warning, parent notification, or expulsion from the dance. When actions warrant, police referrals will be made. While not an exhaustive list, the following offenses may result in disciplinary action:

- ◆ entering a restricted area without authorization
- ◆ loitering
- ◆ insubordination
- ◆ obscenity; vulgar acts including verbal or physical statements written or displayed on clothing; the use of insulting abusive, vulgar, profane or irreverent language
- ◆ refusal to follow rules or regulations as determined by the school officials present
- ◆ vandalism
- ◆ threatening or actual violence or physical force directed toward a chaperone, school personnel, or fellow student
- ◆ conduct which endangers the health, property, or safety of others
- ◆ theft or unauthorized possession of property
- ◆ gambling or extortion
- ◆ possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs
- ◆ carrying or having in their possession a concealed weapon
- ◆ possession or use of tobacco products
- ◆ disrupting the ability of school authorities to maintain order

Digital Tickets for Home Athletic Events

Martin Luther athletics will be moving to digital tickets only for our home athletic events which we charge admission for (basketball, track, volleyball, football, and all WIAA tournament events). We will no longer accept cash at any of our home athletic events. All tickets will be sold through the Martin Luther Athletics page sponsored by Ticket Spicket. This decision was made based on the suggestion and collaboration of the Martin Luther administration team. Please see below additional information regarding our home game policies moving forward.

Home Game Ticket Purchasing for basketball, football, volleyball, track and all WIAA tournament events

1. All tickets must be purchased online. We will no longer accept cash at any of our home athletic events for ticket sales. Tickets can be purchased at <http://spicket.events/martinluther>
****Please see the link below.****
2. Tickets will go on sale 1 week before each event start date.
3. When arriving at the event your ticket will be scanned. You can either show us your ticket on your cellular device to be scanned, or you can print your tickets at home to hand in and be scanned.
4. **For all games, ticket sales will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the varsity game the day of the event. (This is subject to change for larger events and will be communicated ahead of time).**
5. Gates will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the game for all home events. Any individual not in the event 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the game, will not be allowed to enter whether they have purchased a ticket or not.
6. Refunds will only be issued for canceled events that will not be rescheduled. No refunds will be given for any other reason.
7. There will be no re-entry upon exiting the event. Once an individual leaves, they will not be allowed back into the event.
8. All middle/elementary school students must be accompanied by an adult. Any middle/elementary students not accompanied by an adult will not be allowed into the game. The cost of an elementary/middle school ticket is \$2 and must be purchased online.

9. Passes

- a. Metro Classic Conference, Midwest Classic Conference, Woodland and Capital North for Football ONLY.
 - b. Metro Classic Conference ONLY for girls' volleyball, basketball and track are still allowed at the gate, a digital ticket is not required.
 - c. ML Season Adult and Family passes, ML alumni passes, special youth night passes and LHSAGM passes are still allowed at the game, a digital ticket is not required.
10. Children 6 and under are free with an adult, no ticket is required for the child.
 11. Martin Luther students are allowed in for free with their student ID. No student ID means no admittance.
 12. Any Martin Luther staff member will be permitted into the game free with their school ID, no digital ticket will be required. Anyone else accompanying a Martin Luther staff member (spouse, friends, children, etc.) will require a digital ticket.
 13. Please note for WIAA tournament events everyone will be required to have a digital ticket as WIAA does not allow passes and free admission.

MARTIN LUTHER ATHLETICS HOME GAME TICKET PROTOCOLS

All tickets must be purchased online at <http://spicket.events/martinluther>. No cash at the gate.

1. Tickets will go on sale one week before each event start date.
2. For all games, ticket sales will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of the varsity game on the day of the event. (This is subject to change for larger events and will be communicated ahead of time)
3. Gates will close 30 minutes after the scheduled start time of all Varsity games. Anyone not in the event at that time will not be allowed to enter.
4. No refunds will be given unless the game is canceled.
5. There will be no re-entry upon exiting the event.
6. All middle/elementary school students must be accompanied by an adult.
7. Conference and ML passes will still be accepted. No digital ticket required.
8. Children 6 and under are free with an adult; no ticket is required for the child
9. Martin Luther students are allowed in for free with their student ID. No digital ticket required. Must have ID.
10. Martin Luther staff members are allowed in for free with a Staff ID. No digital ticket required. Must have ID.
11. No free admission or passes for WIAA events. Digital ticket required.

Wisconsin Tax Deduction

Beginning with the tax year 2014, the State of Wisconsin has introduced a new legislation (**Wis. Stat. § 71.05(6)(b)49**), in which private school tuition payments paid on or after January 1, 2014 are now eligible for an annual income tax deduction. Qualified taxpayers may potentially claim up to the deduction limit for each dependent child in grades Kindergarten through 8th and up to the deduction limit for each dependent child in grades 9th through 12th. Tuition claimed must be paid in the tax year in which it is being filed. This 2022 tax year, many families may have two tax statements, one from TADS and another from SchoolAdmin. Below are the links for you to access both systems to get your information.

For any payments made for the tax year 2022 for the 2022-23 school year, you will need to access the tax form from [SchoolAdmin](#). To obtain your tuition payments, log into your SchoolAdmin account and click the billing tab. The tax statement is a link located within the ledger header.
