

PSAT/NMSQT - LAST WEEK TO REGISTER



# The PSAT/NMSQT exam will be administered at <u>8</u> a.m. on Tuesday, 10/22.

### PSAT/NMSQT - (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)

- Student Guide and National Merit Scholarship Program information <u>here</u>. Practice exams are also available and other information can be found <u>here</u>.
- College bound Juniors should plan on taking the PSAT/NMSQT. When students take the PSAT/NMSQT, they're automatically screened for the National Merit Scholarship Program, an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.
- When students take the PSAT/NMSQT, they have the option to participate in the College Board's Student Search Service, which makes their names and information available to colleges and scholarship programs looking for students like them.

\*\* JUNIORS should register for the PSAT/NMSQT by Thursday, 10/10. \*\*

Sophomores with 3.75 cumulative g.p.a. or higher may register beginning Friday, 10/4 (depending on test availability)

• Register for the PSAT on e-Funds, or students may see Mr. Langenkamp across from Room 103 by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>10/10</u> for other payment methods.

- Testing is not mandatory but is strongly encouraged.
- The fee for the PSAT is \$18 please make checks payable to Martin Luther High School or follow instructions below to pay through e-Funds. Students may be eligible for fee waivers. Please see Mr. Langenkamp across from Rm. 103, or email <a href="mailto:KLangenkamp@MartinLutherHS.org">KLangenkamp@MartinLutherHS.org</a> for more information.
- During Resource (after 2<sup>nd</sup> hr.) on Thursday, 10/17, students will attend a session for the Digital Readiness Check through the Bluebook testing program that will be used on Chromebooks.
- Check-in begins at 7:30 on 10/22. Testing will begin at 8:00 and students will finish by 11:45. At this time, Students will be released to go to period 5A.

**Payment** can be made by credit card through **e-Funds** (preferred) for this exam. Visit this <u>website</u> provided by your school, or parents may access Skyward, click Food Service, and click EFS link (e-Funds for Schools). No separate login is required.

### AP EXAM REGISTRATION BEGINS TODAY!

For students enrolled in AP courses, they have received information about AP exam registration, including the <u>full schedule</u>, with ML exams beginning May 5, 2025.

### **1ST SEMESTER**

By 10/11: All students add themselves to their AP course rosters (even if you're not planning to take the exam). This can be done in class using your account on MyAP.CollegeBoard.org. Contact your teacher for the Join Code.

Log-in and indicate in your account on the above website your intention to take the exam by selecting "Yes" from the drop-down option.

10/4: AP exam registration begins (full year courses)

11/13: AP exam registration ends at 3:30 p.m.

11/15: There is an additional \$40 late fee charged to students enrolled in **full year** AP courses if they decide they want to take a full year course exam **after** 11/15/2024 and by 3/12/2025

### **2ND SEMESTER**

1/24/2025: Deadline for AP Coordinator to apply for students testing with accommodations (504 or ILP)

1/31: AP English Language exam registration begins (this is offered as a 2<sup>nd</sup> sem. course only at ML)

3/12: AP English Language exam registration ends at 3:30 p.m.

3/12: Deadline for late fee registration – College Board fee of \$40 PLUS cost of exam (\$99) = \$139

3/12: Deadline for exam cancellations in order to receive full refund. Partial refunds (balance paid minus \$40) for any cancellations between NOON on 3/12 and day of exam.

### **Details:**

- Exam fee is \$99 (or \$147 for AP Capstone courses Seminar or Research)
- \$40 down payment required to cover cost of each exam. Remaining \$59 (or \$107 for AP Capstone courses) due by 5/2/2023.
- Fee reduction (\$46) available for students who qualify based on family financial circumstances. Parent must contact Mr. Kirk Langenkamp, AP Coordinator, at <a href="mailto:klangenkamp@martinlutherhs.org">klangenkamp@martinlutherhs.org</a>. Will reduce cost PER EXAM down to \$53 exam fee (or \$101 for AP Capstone courses).
- Students are expected to take the exam on the regularly scheduled CollegeBoard exam date. Any requests for late testing, or an alternate date due to athletic contest, academic event should be made well in advance of the regularly scheduled exam date.
- Information regarding the April AP Pre-Administration meeting will be announced in March.
- Cash, checks or money order (made payable to Martin Luther High School) are accepted forms of payment in Student Services office, if families prefer not to use a credit card for e-Funds (directions below).
- e-Funds: Parents may access Skyward, click Food Service, and click EFS link (e-Funds for Schools). No separate login is required. Or, please follow directions below for e-Funds access.



#### Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:

SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider. SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.

Activity Scheduler from rSchool Today - is the Master Calendar for everything at ML and can be found on the school website under "Current Families"/Master-Athletic Calendar. When you access this calendar, there are some features you may want to use:
