

New Policy This School Year

Let's Go Blue for a Cause!

The Martin Luther chapter of the National Honor Society is currently sponsoring a fundraiser to raise money to help Pastor Waldek Wunsz and his wife Ewa in their humanitarian efforts. Pastor Wunsz serves at Parafia Ewangelicko - Augsburska Świętego Ducha (Lutheran Parish of the Holy Spirit), in Konin, Poland. He and his wife Ewa, along with their two boys, have been working to help Ukrainian refugees in their area. When I spoke to Natalia, a refugee, at English Bible Camp this summer, she told me she and her family expected to be in Poland for a week or two, three tops. They've now been there for about six months. Poland has grown by 2,000,000 people, housing is in short supply, as is food, and there aren't enough jobs. Our fundraising goal is \$9,000, which is about 36,000 PLN (Polish currency). To make the fundraiser fun, we had some staff step up.

If we raise \$3,000, Mr. Romano has offered to dye his hair blue (The Ukrainian flag is blue and gold)

If we raise \$6,000, Dr. Jensen's hair turns blue.

If we raise \$9,000, Mr. Wollersheim will join the fun.

The winning group (freshmen, sophomore, junior, senior, or staff) will earn a casual day (week if we hit \$9,000).
