Student Handbook 2024 - 2025

Signed Acknowledgment Page Reminder

Parents/Guardians:

Each student received a copy of the ML Student Handbook Tuesday (8/27) and should have brought it home. Mr. Wollersheim (Dean of Students) and I went through some of the key points during Resource; attendance policy, dress code, cell phone usage.

Key points:

10. Attendance

- It is important that you student be in attendance for the school day. If your student is not able to be at school, it is your responsibility to make sure the office has been notified of their absence. Please see 10.1 for that procedure. Please also note that if your student is chronically absent (10.5) there can be a forfeiture of credit for classes they miss. All students should be on time to school and classes, there are consequences for being tardy to class during the day and late to school each morning, please see 10.7.

13. Dress Code

- Please note boys can wear stud earring and nose piercings must be a

stud. If you have a ring you will be asked to take it out. Crop tops are not allowed, shirts that have been tied up are also not allowed if they also show skin. Your student will be asked to untie the shirt. Athletic wear is not allowed; sweatpants, yoga pants, spandex shorts, athletic shorts, athletic plastic sandals (Adidas, Nike, Yeezy). Students are allowed to wear shorts during August, September, October, April, and May.

15.1 Cell Phones

- Students are not allowed to utilize their cellphones or have them visible during the hours of 8am-3:15pm. With the exception of study hall, lunch, part of a specific learning activity, or if authorized by school administration. See the handbook for the consequences of not adhering to the policy. This also includes Air Pods, headphones, smartwatches, etc. (15.2)

There is much more information in the handbook, and we encourage you to continually review the handbook with your student(s).

After you and your student have reviewed the handbook, each student and parent will sign the acknowledgement page and return that page to the main office.

School Website - is www.martinlutherhs.org. If you hover over **Current Families**, most of the information that parents need can be found here.

Activity Scheduler from rSchool Today - is the **Master Calendar** for everything at ML and can be found on the [school website](http://www.martinlutherhs.org) under **Current Families/Master-Athletic Calendar**. When you access this calendar, there are some features you may want to use:

- You can choose from the "View Schedules" box on the right-hand side to select specific activities
- You can sign up to receive email reminders of events (Choose the "notify me" section and follow the step-by-step instructions). You will also receive notification if an event changes.
- You can get the mobile app. The application can be found by searching

"rSchool today" and finding the "Activity Scheduler". It has a blue hat with RST on the correct app. After downloading, you will need to select **Wisconsin, Metro Classic**, and then select **Martin Luther**. Just click on the app, and you will see the ML schedule for the day!
