Martin Luther HS students benefit from Wisconsin law, requiring bus service for private and parochial school students in districts that provide bus service to public schools.

The Milwaukee Transit System provides regularly scheduled routes to Southridge Mall and Walmart. Students who have access to the city bus service will have transportation available from early morning until late at night.

During May, our school office must submit a list of students to the school districts who provide transportation reimbursement. Once each school district receives the student list, families will receive a transportation contract to sign and return.
